



## BOARD APPOINTS FIVE NEW MEMBERS TO CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Yorba Linda Water District's Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) meets this morning with a full membership of twelve after the Board of Directors appointed five new members to the Committee. Gus Bruner, Richard Buck, Fred Hebein, Joe Holdren and Daniel Mole, all of Yorba Linda, were selected by the YLWD Board after conducting interviews in a Special Meeting on Wednesday, April 20<sup>th</sup>.
